-DEFINITION OF THE STUDY PLAN

Students have the possibility to freely choose the courses to include in their study plan, even outside the courses offered by the Doctoral School, within third level teaching offered by the University. The study plan proposed by the doctoral student must be approved by the student's tutor before passing to the Teaching Committee (Collegio Docenti).

-WRITING AND FORMATTING THE FINAL THESIS

PhD students who have reached the end of their study and research period are invited to write their thesis in the format they consider most appropriate, defined in agreement with their Tutor (and possibly co-Tutor). In the faculty meeting of November 16, 2022, the faculty board resolved that the theses may also be written and presented, at the choice of the student, as a compendium of the articles published (or in the publication / submission phase) during the doctoral course. In this case, the theses will have to be integrated by a general introductory chapter, possibly by a general methodological description, and by a final chapter of conclusions and perspectives. In all cases, the theses must be written in English.

Regulations for Integrative Teaching and Tutoring Activities of PhD students

- Resolution for integration of Art. 29 paragraph 4 of the Regulations on Research Doctorates, approved by the Academic Faculty Board in the session of 19 October 2022.

The Academic Faculty Board of the PhD School establishes a maximum limit of hours that the students of the doctoral course can devote to seminars (integrative/supplementary teaching) and tutoring.

The limit is set at a <u>maximum of 50 hours per year</u>, corresponding to the sum of the hours dedicated to each activity defined in Article 29, paragraph 4 of the University Regulations on PhD (integrative/supplementary teaching activity + tutoring).
